

Policies for LILSL summer O26 league:

1. We follow the same rules as Over 26 league with NO slide tackling. Refs may adjust time to quarter games if warranted by heat.
2. All games are played at SUNY Stonybrook P Lot Fields.
3. All games start at 7:00pm sharp and will have a running clock as of 7pm.
4. All rainouts will be called at the field unless Stonybrook closes the fields. Check the web site. It will be posted by 5pm if SB closes.
5. Registration fee for summer is \$75. Players must sign a roster, pay and then she will receive her pass. Any new summer players must have a small picture and license to have a pass made.
6. All players are responsible for having their summer league pass at each game and must present their pass to the ref prior to playing. NO PASS= NO PLAY.
7. Players are responsible for returning passes to a board member at the end of the summer. They can be mailed if need be to Jackie Redler, 126 Carriage Lane, Plainview, NY 11803. If passes are not returned there will a \$10 charge for replacement prior to registering again.
8. Games are Thursdays: July 7, 14, 21, 28 and August 4, 11, 18
9. We will try to honor preferences to play on the same team as best as possible.
10. Game schedule, teams and color of shirts are randomly assigned by my children who have no clue as to what is going on.
11. Registration dates to be determined and will be posted on the website. If there is a problem you can contact me at LIYenta33@aol.com.
12. You must play with the team you sign a roster with as per League rules. Anyone found team hopping will be asked to leave the summer league. Any "borrowing" of players between two teams facing each other on a given night must be approved by a board member before the start of the game.

Rosters can be downloaded from the website and mailed either individually or as a group with accompanying checks. Please make a column for t-shirt size and include a t-shirt size for everyone. Anyone not listed with a size will get a large. There are no number assignments. They are randomly given by the person who does them. Very little choice of color as well. Only first time summer players must show for a registration date with a picture and license. No one is assigned to a team unless she has signed and paid. All teams will be made by the first game.
