## PLAY OFF INFORMATION Revised July 2021

## SEMI FINALS

If your team is in the Semi Finals: This game can end in a tie.
$1^{\text {st }}$ Place vs $8^{\text {th }}$ Place, ( If there are only 7 teams in this division $1^{\text {st }}$ Place has a BYE ) , $2^{\text {nd }}$ Place vs $7^{\text {th }}$ Place, $3^{\text {rd }}$ Place vs $6^{\text {th }}$ Place, $\& 4^{\text {th }}$ Place vs $5^{\text {th }}$ Place

If, (for example): The team that is in $1^{\text {st }}$ place before the game has 16 points and loses in the semifinals to the $8^{\text {th }}$ place team, the $1^{\text {st }}$ place team now has 17 points.

They are probably still in $1^{\text {st }}$ or $2^{\text {nd }}$ place because of the total point(s) they have earned.
Therefore, they will play the Final game as $1^{\text {st }}$ or $2^{\text {nd }}$.
The team that was in $8^{\text {th }}$ place, whom have now won in the semifinal now has 9 points (in theory), might move up to $6^{\text {th }}$ place, because of the total points algorithm. That team will then/now play the $5^{\text {th }}$ place team in the Finals.

If in the event there is no $8^{\text {th }}$ place team, the 1st place team will have a bye in the first round (semifinal game) giving 3 points, in order to remain in $1^{\text {st }}$ place

## FINALS

If your team is in the Finals: (Even if you did not play a semifinal game and you went directly to the Finals),

THE FINALS WILL BE BASED ON THE TOTAL POINTS FOR PLACEMENT
$1^{\text {st }}$ place vs $2^{\text {nd }}$ place, $3^{\text {rd }}$ place vs $4^{\text {th }}$ place, $5^{\text {th }}$ place vs $6^{\text {th }}$ place, and $7^{\text {th }}$ place vs $8^{\text {th }}$ place
If there is no $8^{\text {th }}$ place team in this division. The losing team from the play off, between the $5^{\text {th }} \&$ $6^{\text {th }}$ place game, will play the following week against the $7^{\text {th }}$ place team.

The losing team between the $5^{\text {th }} \& 6^{\text {th }}$ place will be the home team the following week. This game must have a winner. If the game is tied at the end of regulation play, we go directly to kicks from the mark (penalty kicks).

The winning team of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Place VS $2^{\text {nd }}$ Place game would take $1^{\text {st }}$ Place for the season. The winning team of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ Place VS $4^{\text {th }}$ Place game would take $3^{\text {rd }}$ Place for the season; So on, and so on.

If one team is short and only has 9 players, the opposing team will only need to have 9 players take part in the shooting. That is if it goes that far (Reduce to Equate).
